



Nevada contractor's awards given to Q&D, RHP Mechanical

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Q&D Construction and RHP Mechanical Systems were named Wednesday night as top general contractor and subcontractor for 2010 by the Nevada chapter of the Associated General Contractors.

The awards were announced as part of the 300-member Nevada chapter's annual convention at the Atlantis Casino Resort Spa.

Sparks-based Q&D Construction was founded in 1964 and among the 2010 projects were improvements at McCarran Boulevard and Interstate 80 in northwest Reno and reconstruction and improvements on Pyramid Way in Sparks.

Reno-based RHP Mechanical Systems, founded in 1950, has worked on manufacturing and industrial facilities, hotel-casinos, low- and high-rise offices, shopping centers, food-service buildings, multiple-family dwellings and residential services.
